

CycleHero Competition Terms and Conditions

Competition Entrants

1. To enter this competition you must be at least 12 years of age.
2. Employees of CTC, their immediate families, agencies of CTC and anyone else professionally connected with the competition may not enter. CTC reserves the right to verify that this condition is complied with.
3. By entering the competition you hereby warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete.

Competition entries

4. Entry is by submission of a link to an original video or animation including a pedal cycle (unicycle, bicycle, tricycle) hosted on www.youtube.com via the official form provided on www.cyclehero.com. Video should be taken with one of the entry categories listed on www.cyclehero.com in mind.
5. The videos that submitted links point to must be the original work of the competition entrant.
6. The competition is open from 18 June 2007 and will run until October 1st 2007.
7. Entrants must obtain consent of all identifiable individuals within their video and all permissions necessary for copyrighted material. By submission of a video to the competition all participants will be deemed to have obtained these consents. Prizes will be withdrawn if any entrant is found not to have obtained consent from all identifiable individuals in their video.
8. Entrants will be required to state a valid e-mail address, telephone number and postcode in the registration form. In the event that complete and correct information is not provided, the form will be considered incomplete and therefore invalid. Invalid forms will not be accepted as valid entries to the competition.
9. Entrants may submit one link to a video per entry. Entrants may make multiple entries.
10. Entrants are required to make available a copy video in a stand alone computer file in an accessible format to the Promoter and their Agents for editing and redistribution. Entrants may be contacted and requested to supply the video with 48 hours.
11. CTC accepts no responsibility for loss or damage of content during the competition entry process, nor for any delay or disruption or corruption caused by any equipment or network failure.
12. All videos will be vetted and may be rejected at the sole discretion of the Promoter. Content must not whether actually or in the opinion of the Promoter be dangerous, obscene, pornographic, violent, and sexually explicit or contravene any laws relating to sexual, religious or political freedoms, or be racially or sexually discriminatory or likely to cause offence. Only approved videos will be entered into the competition.
13. Incomplete entries or entries that are not in accordance with the entry instructions will be deemed to be invalid.
14. Entries that are deemed to be invalid are still bound by the Terms and Conditions and all rights remain with the Promoter.
15. By entering this promotion all participants will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the Terms and Conditions. All entry instructions form part of the Terms and Conditions.
16. If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these Terms and Conditions, or the spirit of the promotion, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, refuse to process a claim. The Promoter will be the final arbiter in any decisions and these will be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
17. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and the rules of the competition at any time without prior notice. Changes will be posted on www.cyclehero.com.

Prizes

18. A selection of competition entries may be made available for viewing from the www.cyclehero.com website. The selection of videos on the website will be made by the promoter at their sole discretion. Selection does not mean that a prize has or will be awarded.

19. Under no circumstances whatsoever will you be refunded or compensated in cash or in kind for any use whatsoever of your image by CTC or its agencies, even if your video is selected as one of the winning images.
20. There will be 1 overall best video winner who will receive a Specialized bike as seen in the CycleHero movie, additionally 4 category winners who will receive a £100 prize. Entrants outside the UK may be required to pay shipping costs.

21. Winners will be notified by October 19th 2007.
22. The 1 overall winner and the 4 category winners will be selected by the group of judges. The judging will be conducted under independent supervision and the Promoter's decision is final. No correspondence about the judges' decisions will be entered into. The prize-winners will be the individual who submitted the video to the www.cyclehero.com competition site. No other individual, whether featured in the winning video or not, is eligible to claim the prize. The winner of the Specialized bike may nominate another individual to receive the bike as a gift.
23. In the event of unforeseen circumstances the Promoter reserves the right to offer alternative prizes of equal or greater value. No cash alternative will be offered for the prizes. All prizes are non-transferable.

Such information will not be used for any other purposes than as stated in these Terms and Conditions.
27. Winners may be required to take part in promotional activity. The Promoter reserves the right to use the names and addresses of winners, their photographs or video or audio recordings of them in publicity and promotion.

Liability

28. The Promoter does not condone any dangerous or unsafe activity and will not be liable for any damage or injury caused in the filming / production of the competition video entries. If in doubt, do not take a risk.
29. The Promoter cannot accept any responsibility for any loss, injury, damage or disappointment by any person entering the competition or as a result of accepting a prize.
